Antonis Glytzouris is Associate Professor at the School of Drama of the Aristotle University (Thessaloniki) and supervisor of the theatre history research project at the Institute for Mediterranean Studies (Crete). He is the author of the books *Stage Direction in Greece; The Rise and Consolidation of the Stage Director in Modern Greek Theatre* (University of Crete Press, Herakleio, 2011); *Wishes of an Eagle, Wings of a Butterfly; Nikos Kazantzakis' Early Dramas and the European Avant-Garde; A Contribution to the Study of Decadence in the Modern Greek Theatre of the early 20th century* (University of Crete Press, Herakleio, 2009). His current research centres on the reception of Realism and Modernism in the Modern Greek theatre. His essays have appeared in such journals as *Ibsen Studies, New Theatre Quarterly, Theatre Histories Studies, International Journal of the History of Sport,* and *Journal of Modern Greek Studies.*
